In a visual presentation of her award-winning book **Bitter Sweet**, Kitty Morse explores her ancestors' lives in Occupied France, relatives who perished in the Holocaust. Inside a tattered valise, Kitty discovered the diary of her great-grandfather, army doctor Prosper Lévy-Neymarck, which chronicles the invasion of Alsace-Lorraine in 1940. In addition, she found her great-grandmother Blanche's notebook containing nearly 100 handwritten recipes, including a unique Alsatian carrot cake.
